



World Raffa Championship – ARGENTINA (4-11 March 2019)

Single men, single women, and mixed doubles

Bocce Confederation of Argentina is going to host the **World Raffa Championship** with the new format adopted by CBI in three disciplines; single men, single women, and mixed-doubles which will be played for the first time in world championships. The championship will be open to all affiliated member federations and this will be the last championship played without continental quotas. Only the member federations which paid CBI annual membership fee 2019 **before 31.01.2019** will be allowed to participate.

We are glad to invite all countries to take part in this very special occasion to be a part of this historical event in our sport.

1. Program of the competition

- The delegations travelling from different continents should arrive on the 4th March 2019, and the delegations from Pan-American countries should arrive on the 5th March 2019.
- Competitions will be played from the 6th March until the 10th March 2019 and the delegations will depart on the 11th March 2019.
- Please refer to the attached document for **Draft Program** of the competitions designed according to 32 teams.

2. Accommodation and organization costs

- According to decision taken by CBI, the delegations will be composed of **4 to 6 persons in total**; 2 players (1 male & 1 female), 2 delegates and 1 male or 1 female or a couple. This additional person can play only the mixed couple and the nations have to pay for these athletes **€ 40 per person and day**.
- Each person in the official delegation will have to pay **25 Euros per day** during the official days.
- For extra days and all other extra persons **40 Euros per day per person** will be charged by the organizer. These prices will cover, transfers from the airport, accommodation in double/triple rooms, and the meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner). For single rooms **20 Euros per day** will be charged.
- The international referees will be hosted free of charge by the organizer. The travel costs of the referees will be paid by their own federation.

3. Transfer of delegations

All the delegations arriving to Cordoba International Airport (COR/SACO) will be transferred by the host. The transfers between the competition venue and the hotels will also be arranged by the host.

4. Visa issues

All the teams need visa to enter Argentina should send their name list composed of;

1. Name and surname
2. Date of birth
3. Passport number and expiry date.

in time to start the visa procedure immediately.

5. Technical regulations

Detailed technical regulations will be shared by the Technical Committee of CBI along with final registration forms very soon.
